It is with deep regret that I share with you news of the passing of our founder and President, Rabbi Dr. Bernard Lander זצ"ל

First and foremost we extend our heartfelt condolences to the Lander family on the loss of their dear father, brother, grandfather and great grandfather. We at Touro share the family's enormous pain; Dr. Lander's passing is a profound loss. His vision and leadership has been phenomenal. His care and concern for the Jewish people and all of humanity knew no bounds.
