Breakfast and lunch will be served.

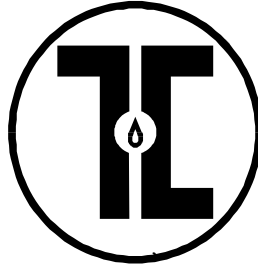
