Faculty Development Day

On Wednesday, November 11, 2009, over 250 members of the Touro faculty will attend the 21st Faculty Development Day at the Midtown site on 23rd Street in Manhattan. The theme of this fall's conference is "Our Changing Educational Environment." Dr. Sabra Brock, of the Business faculty is the keynote speaker, discussing "Adapting to Change." The seven faculty workshops include "Exploring Change," "Working with Learning Resistances," "Liberal Arts – Love 'em or Leave 'em," "Promoting Civility in the Classroom," "A Library/Faculty Collaboration on Academic Honesty and Plagiarism," "Extending Your Classroom Through Experiential Learning" and "Applying Technology to Educational Strategies." . The day-long event includes a continental breakfast and a light lunch followed by department meetings.

There are three Faculty Development events each year, two at the Midtown campus in the fall and one at the Avenue J campus in the spring. The day conferences are repeated in the evening at the Brighton campus.
