The Graduate School of Psychology of Touro College seeks highly qualified professionals for three full-time teaching positions. Areas of specialty include: School Psychology and Child-Clinical Psychology. Candidates with other expertise who have exceptional credentials will also be considered. The three positions will be at the Assistant or Associate Professor rank.

The Graduate School offers master's programs in School Psychology and Mental Health Counseling and has a proposal for a Psy.D. Program in School and Educational Psychology.

Successful candidates should be able to teach in all of the programs. Candidates must have an active research program; eligibility for the Associate Professor rank requires a significant publication record. Doctorate is required for all positions. All prospective faculty are expected to apply for external funding to support their research – persons with a record of funding will be given preference. Salary is competitive and dependant on credentials and experience.
