The 150 Hour Rule - August 1, 2009
Prepare for the New York State CPA Exam!

The 150 Hour Rule and August 1, 2009

Beginning August 1, 2009, New York State requires candidates for the CPA exam to have completed 150 semester hours in lieu of the current 120 hour requirement. Anticipating this professional requirement, Touro College's Graduate School of Business, is now offering a Master of Science in Accounting degree.

The degree, a 16-month, 30-credit program, enables accounting professionals to prepare for the CPA exam.

Program Requirements

Applicants should have an undergraduate degree in accounting.

Applicants with undergraduate degrees in other business or non-business related disciplines will be evaluated for admission to the program. As a result, pre-program prerequisite courses in accounting and business may be required.
