First Jewish University to open in Italy

The first Jewish University in Italy, a branch of the prestigious Touro College, a Jewish-sponsored independent institution of higher and professional education with over 20,000 students in the US, Russia, Germany and Israel, will open its doors next year in Zagarolo, 30 minutes by train from Rome, to 150 freshmen, on the initiative of Rabbi Mino Bahbout.

The university, complete with a kosher

kitchen, will be located in Palazzo Rospigliosi (photo), which has been made available to Touro College by the Province of Rome. The opening courses will be offered at the Faculty of

Administration and Economics, followed by the Science of Education, Psychology and Medicine.



Classes, open to students of all denominations, Italian and Europeans, will be held in English, while Jewish studies will be conducted also in Italian and Hebrew. Mornings will be devoted to Hebrew studies, followed by chosen subjects in the afternoons. www.touro.edu <
