



## **Las Vegas hospital begins osteopathic residency program**

LAS VEGAS Twenty-five medical school graduates have begun a unique rotation at a Las Vegas hospital—as part of the state’s first osteopathic residency program.

Valley Hospital Medical Center is collaborating in the program with Touro University Nevada College of Osteopathic Medicine.

Officials say training D-O’s in Las Vegas matches graudate medical resident with a state where a fast-growing population needs more doctors.
