The BS in Health Science/MS in Occupational Therapy Program at the Manhattan campus of Touro College invites applications for a full-time faculty position and a full-time Academic Fieldwork Coordinator.

**Full-time faculty** responsibilities include teaching, student advisement, program/school committee work and scholarly activity. **Minimum qualifications for full-time faculty:** New York State Licensure/eligibility in occupational therapy, relevant Masters Degree (doctorate preferred), five years professional experience in clinical practice of which two must include teaching in higher education. Applicants must demonstrate strong teaching, scholarly research and clinical skills. Applicants with content expertise in splinting, biological sciences, or psychosocial practice especially desirable. Position requires faculty to be on campus a minimum of 21 hours per week.

Anticipated start date is December 2007. Salary and academic rank commensurate with qualifications and experience.

**Academic Fieldwork Coordinator:** An immediate opening exists for an academic fieldwork coordinator at the Manhattan campus. This administrative position is full time and requires a minimum of 28 hours on site. The schedule is flexible. **Minimum qualifications include:** NY State professional license or eligibility; 3 years clinical experience *INCLUDING* 1 year's experience as a student supervisor; Baccalaureate or Master degree in occupational therapy. Candidates with a graduate level degree preferred. Excellent organization and communication skills necessary. Familiarity with the boroughs of New York City, New Jersey, and Long Island a plus. Experience with word processing and data base/data entry helpful.
